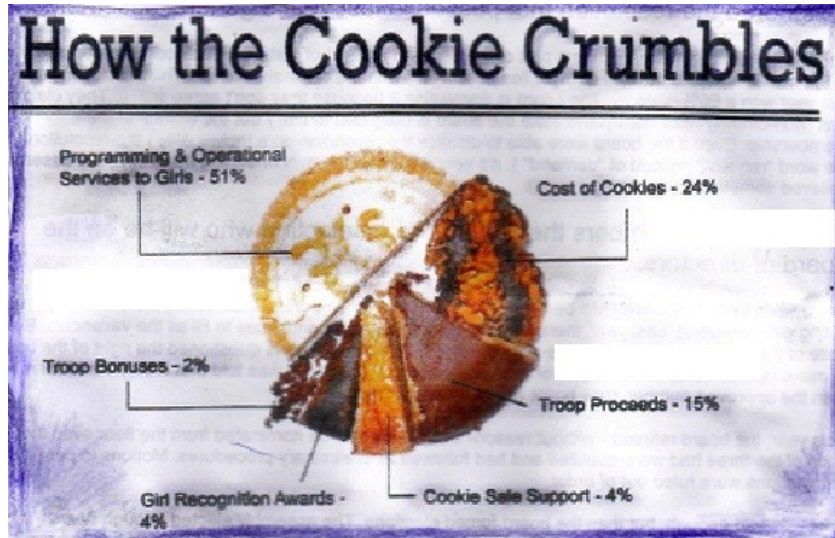


Girl Scout troops get about

Support the GIRLS in Girl Scouts

Instead of buying cookies, give \$\$ directly to a girl and her troop.

Consider these facts:

- 2011: **our girls raise \$8.4M in product sales** (mostly cookies).* That's 77% of the council's yearly income.
- More than **50% of girls camped** at the 14 council camps when they were still open. 95% of girls enjoyed outdoor activities and were interested in camping.
- Council spends **less than 9% of its budget on camp maintenance** — with complaints from GSNEO board about even this small amount spent on camps.
- 2011: GSNEO Board plans to sell all but 2 camps, so General Assembly passes formal resolution for halt of sales of camps until plan is re-evaluated and approved by the Assembly. **Board continues to ignore this resolution.**
- For two years, **the board has not followed council bylaws**, refusing to allow the GSNEO General Assembly to fairly elect new board members.
